



IMPERVIOUS AREA WORKSHEET

Impervious Area is the area of the completed development that will not absorb or infiltrate rainfall or drainage. **It is the built area of the site, including all hardscape.**

Use the table below to estimate the final impervious surface area for your construction project.

What is included in an impervious area calculation?

- Building roof area footprint(s) (including porches and eaves)
- Outbuilding roof area footprint(s) (including porches and eaves)
- All paved or compacted aggregate areas, including:
 - Driveways
 - Parking areas
 - Patios
 - Traditionally installed tile, modular paving or brick surfaces
 - Pathways and trails
 - Fire Department turnarounds
 - Access roads
- Swimming pools
- Tennis/basketball courts, etc.
- All surfaces designed to shed water

Only the total area needs to be entered in acres.
