

IV. OLD BUSINESS

Inventory Letter to Courthouse Offices Update- The Committee has entrusted Jill Van Buren and Linda Hukari, Court Administrator, to compile a complete inventory of the courthouse, revise the Inventory Letter, send the Letter to John Haroldson for the final approval and send it out to the Committee and staff. The Committee will then revisit the Inventory Letter and address any concerns at a future meeting.

ACTION: Jill and Linda will go through the courthouse and make a thorough inventory and make it available to John Haroldson for approval and then to the Committee and Staff.

- <u>Courthouse Photos/Framing Update</u>- Judy reported to the Committee that
 the 1978 Community Development Award for Benton County was framed and
 will be placed in the Courthouse. Judy presented the bill for framing and
 asked the Committee to approve reimbursement for the expenditure from the
 Courthouse Preservation Fund.
- ACTION: Judy presented the Committee a bill for the framing of the 1978 Community Development Award for reimbursement approval from the Committee. The Committee will vote at next month's meeting.
- Card lock Access to D.A.'s Office Update- Chris reported that the County got the estimate in and it was lower than the estimated cost. There was not a quorum to vote at the meeting. Hon. Rob Gardner moved to approve the Card-Lock and Judy seconded. Voting was done by phone call and the Estimate was approved by a quorum vote. With Judy Juntunen and Hon. Rob Gardner at the Meeting voting yes and Daniel Read, Peter Barnhisel and Cy Stadsvold voting yes via phone call. Scott McClure voting yes by e-mail. The approval for the Card-Lock was approved by vote of the Committee.

ACTION: Chris will give an update to the Committee next month.

V NEW BUSINESS

 <u>Court Personnel Workstation Upgrades</u> – Linda advised the Committee that the Court staff are looking into workstation upgrades. Linda will update the Committee at a future meeting.

ACTION: Linda will make available Court work station upgrade plans to the Committee when they become available.

 New Preservation Projects – Chris briefed the Committee on the dollar amount the Committee had to fund other preservation projects. He suggested that the Committee discuss at their next meeting any preservation projects ideas.

Chris suggested that the Committee look into preservation of the Courthouse and consider having Seismic upgrades done to the building. He mentioned that the upgrades would 1)protect the people who are in the building 2)allow time to get the people out of the building; and 3)preserve the historic building. Chris further discussed that it would take millions to repair the building, if possible, in a disaster. There is a great need for seismic condition preservation and safety.

Judy asked if the seismic upgrade to the building was done that would all of the repairs be noticeable? Chris explained that the repairs and/or seismic upgrades would be behind the original facades and would not be Noticeable. Everything that exists now would be the same after the upgrade.

It was discussed that we explore grants that may help with funding the seismic upgrade. Judy will spearhead an opportunity for the Committee to look at grants and explore the opportunity to look into Grants from SHIPO. Judy will research the criteria and process for the grant funding. Chris also mentioned that the National Preservation Grant may be an option and Judy will look into it.

ACTION: Judy will research and look for possible Grants to help the Preservation of the Courthouse and to help fund the seismic upgrade. She will update the Committee with new preservation

project ideas and bring them to the next meeting to discuss those potential projects and possible Grants at the next meeting.
